MOORESVILLE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, January 20, 2026
6:00 p.m.
StageCoach Tavern

Attending: Mayor Nikki Sprader, Council members Lara Brown, Margaret-Anne Crumlish, Kim Lindaman, Kevin Crumlish, and Rush Mitchell
Absent: none

- The meeting was called to order with a quorum present.
- Council Member Lindaman made a motion to approve the December meeting minutes. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Brown reported ongoing plans for the 2026 Guided Walking Tour series on first Saturday of the Month starting in March with Behind the Scenes of Disney's Filming on Tom & Huck and upcoming Garden tours. Council Member Brown made a motion to increase general guided tours from \$10/person to \$15/person and specialty tours starting at \$20/person. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Brown reported our American250AL event, Mooreville's Great American Picnic, will be June 27th. Council Member Crumlish, K commented that liability of fireworks will need to be considered.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA presented the Rebuild AL Gas Tax Fund Fiscal Year Expenditure Report and asked for it to be published on the website.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA presented and made a motion to approve the Rebuild AL Gas Tax Fund Fiscal Year 2026 Transportation Plan. Council member Mitchell seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously. Council Member Crumlish, MA asked for it to be published on the website.
- Mayor Sprader reminded Council that Council Member Crumlish, MA is the Town's Disaster Plan Coordinator. In the Mayor's absence, Council Member Crumlish, MA has authority to contact the County Commission for assistance.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reviewed the December 2025 financial reports.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reviewed the 2025 annual financial reports.
- Mayor Sprader reported that the relocation of archival records to the back room of the Stagecoach Tavern is underway.
- Council Member Mitchell confirmed annual spring dumpster and Mayor Sprader asked that she coordinate a Brick Church cleaning late spring before DAR Marker Dedication (scheduled for late May-early June).
- Council Member Lindaman handed out a preliminary Town events calendar. A Christmas Tree Lighting was tabled in order for more research on the feasibility of an evergreen tree.

- Mayor Sprader reported that Representative Parker Moore has accepted an invitation to attend the Chili Supper on Feb 21st.
- Mayor Sprader reported that she met with TARCOG's Director of Economic Development & Planning, Lee Terry. Based on eligibility for the HUD Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), Mr. Terry is investigating the possibility of applying for a planning grant to cover the cost of an impact study of potential traffic at Mooresville Road and Old Hwy 20 intersection with upcoming developments. Applications are due mid-summer with TARCOG preparation planning in March.
- Mayor Sprader made a motion to approve the Ordinance 2024-04 Floodplain Development Ordinance presented in December 2025. Council member Brown seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader signed Proclamation 2026-01 - January 2026 Human Trafficking Prevention Month.
- Mayor Sprader reported that Limestone County Historical Society (Kathryn Davis or Richard Martin) will be reaching out concerning the deterioration of the Historical Marker located near the Stagecoach Tavern. Mayor Sprader reported a preliminary cost to repair by Clark Memorials in Decatur (recommended by DAR) is \$750/side.
- Mayor Sprader reported that a Spectrum contractor began first of January measuring utility poles for Broadband construction planning.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. moved to adjourn. Council Member Crumlish, M.A. seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
