MOORESVILLE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, February 17, 2026
6:00 p.m.
StageCoach Tavern

Attending: Mayor Nikki Sprader, Council members Lara Brown, Margaret-Anne Crumlish, Kim Lindaman, Kevin Crumlish, and Rush Mitchell
Absent: none

- The meeting was called to order with a quorum present.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA made a motion to approve the January meeting minutes. Council Member Lindaman seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader reported that 2026 contract has been completed with American Cruise lines.
- Council Member Brown reported Tom and Huck tour tickets were selling and expected full sell out. Council Member Brown asked for clarification on tour expenses. Council Member Crumlish, K reported that expenses will be subtracted from ticket gross sales and motion not needed. Council Member Brown reported budgeted expenses approximately \$100.
- Council Member Brown reported a \$2500 Community Grant through America250AL has been submitted and the DAR Marker Dedication still on track for early June.
- Mayor Sprader reported the County Commissioner will address roadside overgrowth on North Street before springtime. Council Member Crumlish, K believes work has already been completed.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA reported that Bicentennial Garden mulch has been scheduled.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reviewed the January 2026 financial reports.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. made a motion to approve the Limestone County Sheriff's Rodeo sponsorship increase from \$500 to \$750. Council Member Mitchell seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Lindaman reminded everyone of Chili Supper on Feb 21st.
- Council Member Lindaman made a motion to approve a conditional use permit for the Irish Dancing event at the Tavern on March 15th. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader reviewed an extension list of Spring and Summer Dates (see agenda, not listed is March 21st Rocket Run)
- Mayor Sprader gauged Council interest in participating in Athens-Limestone County Chamber & Tourism Map.
- Mayor Sprader reported that WHNT will be live broadcasting the "On the Road" Segment in Mooreville on March 20th with pre-recorded segments with townspeople.

- Council Member Crumlish, K made a motion to approve a conditional use permit for the Huntsville Track Club Rocket Run on March 21st. Council Member Mitchell seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Brown made a motion to approve a conditional use permit for the Sprader family use of the Tavern for a family bridal luncheon on July 17th. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader reported that the Limestone County Historical Society does not have money to repair the deteriorating marker located to north of the Tavern. Mayor Sprader will continue to investigate best option for repair.
- Mayor Sprader reported the ROW Agreement from Spectrum has been sent to Huntsville. Mayor Sprader has sent texts to Senator Orr and Representative Parker that a signed ROW from Hville is the only thing holding up Spectrum's broadband construction to Mooresville.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. moved to adjourn. Council Member Lindaman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
