MOORESVILLE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, March 17, 2026
6:00 p.m.
StageCoach Tavern

Attending: Mayor Nikki Sprader, Council members Lara Brown, Margaret-Anne Crumlish, Kim Lindaman, and Kevin Crumlish
Absent: Rush Mitchell

- The meeting was called to order with a quorum present.
- Council Member Crumlish, Kevin made a motion to approve the February meeting minutes. Council Member Lindaman seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Brown reported Tom and Huck tour grossed \$480 with a projected net of approximately \$330 after materials and fee costs.
- Council Member Brown also reported that the Town has been officially designated an America250AL Semiquincentennial City and has been awarded a \$2,500 Community Grant through America250AL.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA reported that the shoulder and sod work on Lauderdale Street, between the Brick Church and the Post Office, has been completed.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reviewed the February 2026 financial reports.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reported that he will champion the Post Office wood preservative project.
- Mayor Sprader reviewed Spring and Summer calendar items listed on the agenda and highlighted 2025 Statement of Economic Interests are due April 30th to be completed by all Council members.
- Mayor Sprader provided an update on WHNT's live broadcast of the "On the Road" segment in Mooreville on March 20. Channel 19 will be distributing weather radios to residents.
- Mayor Sprader also updated the status of Spectrum broadband. According to Will Edwards with Charter, the right-of-way agreement remains with Huntsville, which has requested an updated map due to recent annexations. The project remains on schedule for September 2026.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA. moved to adjourn. Council Member Brown seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
