MOORESVILLE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, April 21, 2026
6:00 p.m.
StageCoach Tavern

Attending: Mayor Nikki Sprader, Council members Lara Brown, Margaret-Anne Crumlish, Kim Lindaman, Rush Mitchell, and Kevin Crumlish
Absent: None

- The meeting was called to order with a quorum present.
- Council Member Crumlish, Kevin made a motion to approve the March meeting minutes. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Brown reported the May Garden Tour was close to being sold out – 17 of 20.
- Mayor Sprader reported that there's an opportunity to apply for a RC&D grant due by June 30th to reprint Bicentennial Garden Information boards and the Printer and materials are being recommended by John Kelton who is an advisor to Cooks and the National Park Service. Printer would be Southern Custom Exhibits in Anniston, AL.
- Council Member Brown gave update on June 27th America250 event.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA made a motion to approve the Town of Eva Mosquito Spraying Agreement. Council Member Mitchell seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA reported that the spring planting is complete.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reviewed the March 2026 financial reports.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. reported that the Post Office wood preservative project is complete and should be repeated every 6 years.
- Mayor Sprader reported that Littrell Lumber confirmed a completion date of May 14th for PO Screendoors.
- Mayor Sprader reported that FISH Window Cleaning has completed the annual window cleaning in the Brick Church and Tavern.
- Council Member Mitchell reported that the annual Brick Church interior cleaning is complete.
- Mayor Sprader reviewed Spring and Summer calendar items listed on the agenda and highlighted 2025 Statement of Economic Interests are due April 30th to be completed by all Council members.
- Mayor Sprader reported that she met with County Commissioner Chairman Collin Daly and Commissioner Derrick Gatlin on April 14th.

- Mayor Sprader reported that US Representative Dale Strong's Huntsville office can open a Congressional case in Bham if Post Office manning issues continue. However, the Town has been informed that a backup has been identified from the Belle Mina office.
- Mayor Sprader reported that contractors are working to raise power lines and replace poles in preparation for broadband lines. Spectrum last update is Tanner's construction was slated for April/May and Mooresville's goal is early summer.
- Mayor Sprader reported that there has been an inquiry on short term rentals within the residential district of Town and Attorney Black provided the language for a response based on our current ordinances.
- Council Member Crumlish, K. moved to adjourn. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
