MOORESVILLE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, August 18, 2026
6:00 p.m.
StageCoach Tavern

Attending: Mayor Nikki Sprader, Council members Kim Lindaman, Lara Brown, Margaret-Anne Crumlish, Kevin Crumlish and Rush Mitchell
Absent: None

- The meeting was called to order with a quorum present.
- Council Member Brown made a motion to approve the July meeting minutes. Council Member Mitchell referenced a grammatical error and amended motion for correction. Council Member Lindaman seconded, and the appended motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader reported the Tom & Huck September Tour is sold out, with a Gross Profit of \$500. Council Member Brown gave an update about the October Haunted Historical Tours.
- Mayor Sprader reported that Huntsville Utilities has completed maintenance on all fire hydrants, and all hydrants have passed inspection by the Segars Volunteer Fire Department.
- Mayor Sprader presented the 2027 Annual Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan. Council Member Crumlish, MA made a motion to adopt the 2027 Annual Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan. Council Member Mitchell seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Council Member Crumlish, K reviewed the July 2026 financial report and the 2026 Midyear Budget vs Actuals Financial Report.
- Mayor Sprader reported that she will contact John Kelton about starting work on the Bicentennial Garden Info Boards now that the grant money has been received by Parker Moore.
- Mayor Sprader reported that she attended the League of Municipalities' District 5 Fireside Chat with US Representative Dale Strong.
- Council person Brown made a motion to approve the annual renewal for 1818 Farms' conditional use permit. Council person Lindaman seconded the motion and all approved.
- Council person Crumlish, MA made a motion to approve the October Mooreville Church of Christ Car Show conditional use permit. Council person Mitchell seconded the motion and all approved.
- Mayor Sprader announced the opportunity to participate in the 2027 Severe Weather Preparedness Tax Holiday in February. There were no motions put forward to participate. Mayor Sprader will notify the State that Mooreville is not participating.
- Mayor Sprader reported that DAR sent questions about Historic Marker shipping but has not provided any potential installation dates.

- Mayor Sprader reported that Broadband finalization depends on the permitting of crossing the Norfolk Southern Railroad in Belle Mina.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA reported there will be groundbreaking for Westmoore Landing on August 31st and Arrowhead Landing Road will be under construction soon but a detour is available.
- Council Member Crumilsh, K moved to adjourn. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
