MOORESVILLE REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, September 15, 2026
6:00 p.m.
StageCoach Tavern

Attending: Mayor Nikki Sprader, Council members Kim Lindaman, Lara Brown, Margaret-Anne Crumlish, and Rush Mitchell
Absent: Kevin Crumlish

- The meeting was called to order with a quorum present.
- Council Member Brown made a motion to approve the August meeting minutes. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader reported the Historical Haunted Tours in October are just 2 tickets from being sold out, together with a Gross Profit of \$1250. Council Member Brown gave an update about tour content and excitement of the community around 1 social media post announcing the new tour.
- Mayor Sprader reported that Bailey Haak, American Cruise Line Shore Excursion Coordinator replied that 2027 cruises have not been confirmed. However, website shows 19 Tennessee River Cruises and 10 out of 20 Great Smoky Mountains Cruises with Mooreville listed as excursions
- Mayor Sprader reported that the Town received confirmation from Segars Volunteer Fire Department that our ISO Rating has been confirmed as a Class 5 on September 11th.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA reported that no immediate fall planting will occur in front entrance island. Current Lantana will stay until first frost.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA reviewed the August 2026 financial report
- Mayor Sprader reported that she and Council Member Crumlish, K have engaged Accountant, Jeremy Jeffries, to complete the AL State required Annual Finance Report. Council Member Mitchell made a motion to approve moving forward with Mr. Jeffries. Council Member Crumlish, MA seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.
- Mayor Sprader reported that she attended the Limestone County Chamber Washington Update featuring Tommy Tuberville.
- Mayor Sprader reported that Spectrum broadband is now live and she sent out a full town communication via email on September 11th.
- Council Member Crumlish, MA moved to adjourn. Council Member Lindaman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
